The message is simple.....Be Prepared.

With spring upon us, now is the time for students who suffer from Asthma to make sure that they carry their asthma puffer with them in their bag or pocket at all times, particularly when outside during sport and PE.



Due to health regulations, any student who needs to use a spacer to administer their asthma medication will need to provide their own. We have been advised that spacers cannot be washed and then shared between students. The school is more than happy to store your child's labelled spacer in a locked cupboard in the clinic.
