Important information about holidays
As part of the implementation of the National
Standards, holidays taken by students outside
of school vacation periods are included as
absences. Families are encouraged to holiday
or travel during school vacations. If travel
outside of school vacation periods is necessary,
the following considerations apply:

 If the principal accepts the reason for the absence, the absence will be marked as "L" and a Certificate of Extended Leave - Holiday issued. This must be done <u>prior</u> to going on the holiday.

- If the principal does not believe the absence is in the student's best interests and does not accept the reason or if the parents have not approached the principal, the absence will be recorded as "A". A Certificate of Extended Leave - Holiday will not be issued.
- If the period of absence is in excess of 50 days, the student may be eligible to enrol in Distance Education
 Parents/carers should contact the school to obtain an
 Application for Extended Leave
 Travel so their application can be considered in a timely manner.


